Dear Ms. Nasreddine:

This is the final response to your November 2, 2009, Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request, included, and assigned Office of Natural Resources Revenue (ONRR) FOIA No. 2010-002.

Our office identified numerous responsive pages and provided you with interim responses on September 7, October 19, and December 13. This response provides the final 1310 pages. These documents have been uploaded to the MessageWay system. Please contact me if you have any issues retrieving them. As a reminder, your user name is nasreddiner.

Portions of the records responsive to your request have been removed; we also withheld 24 pages in their entirety. These documents and portions are exempt under 5 U.S.C. § (b)(4), (b)(5), and (b)(7)e. The FOIA regulations require us to withhold information protected under FOIA exemptions when disclosure is prohibited by statute or Executive Order. Furthermore, we withhold information under Exemption (b)(5) if that information is not available to a party in litigation with the Department. The information withheld in part consists of commercial, financial information, pre-decisional deliberations and attorney-client material/discussions, and settlement as well as audit strategies.

This decision was made by Mr. Richard Lopez, ONRR FOIA Officer in consultation with Mr. Lance Wenger, Office of the Solicitor, Department of the Interior, Rocky Mountain Region. If you disagree with this determination, you have the right under Department of the Interior regulations at 43 CFR § 2.28 (2012) to appeal. Your appeal may be filed after our final response. You have the right to treat this delay in processing as a denial of your request (43 C.F.R. §2.29(b) (2012)).

Your appeal must include copies of all correspondence between you and the bureau concerning your FOIA request, including your request and the bureau's response (if there is one). Failure to include all correspondence between you and the bureau with your appeal will result in the Department's rejection of your appeal, unless the FOIA Appeals Officer determines, in the FOIA Appeal Officer's sole discretion, that good cause exists to accept the defective appeal. The time limits for responding to your appeal will not begin to run until the documents are received.

For your information, Congress excluded three discrete categories of law enforcement and national security records from the requirements of the FOIA. See 5 U.S.C. § 552(c) (2006 & Supp. IV (2010)). This response is limited to those records that are subject to the requirements of the FOIA. This is a standard notification that is given to all our requesters and should not be taken as an indication that excluded records do, or do not, exist

In accordance with 43 C.F.R. § 2.16 (2012), we assess user fees to fulfill a FOIA request. Personnel charges cover our costs to conduct document searches and to review, identify, and delete privileged and confidential information. Other charges cover the direct costs of providing the material. Included is the final bill for \$12089.69 the cost to complete your request.
